80x86 to 68000 Sourcecode-Converter /// Up to now, if you had to transfer an assembler program to another computer, we had to write a complete new source-code. To reduce this grievance I wrote a converter which translates 80x86 code into 68000 code (e.g. for AMIGA). I set more value on an optimized code than on a 100 % correct translation of the commands. The translated program should have the same speed (I mean the translated code should be more of practical use than of academical benefit). The translated code shouldn't have more lines than the original program.
