It was created by Impulse, Inc. It used the .iob extension for its objects. Imagine was a derivative of the software TurboSilver, which was also for the Amiga and written by Impulse. CAD-Technologies continued the distribution of the Amiga version. Starting with version 5.1, new updates were available for free for current customers as part of the Amiga Constant Upgrade Program (ACUP) up until presumed Imagine 6.0 release. -I-Files manuals (PDF) included and links for additional books. -CUP (Constant Update Program) versions 2.12, 2.13, 2.14, 2.15, 2.16, 2.17, 2.18, 2.19 are included and other versions has additional functionality (eg: 2.19 includes volumetrics and real lights and much faster ray-tracer but other functions may work better in previous versions).
